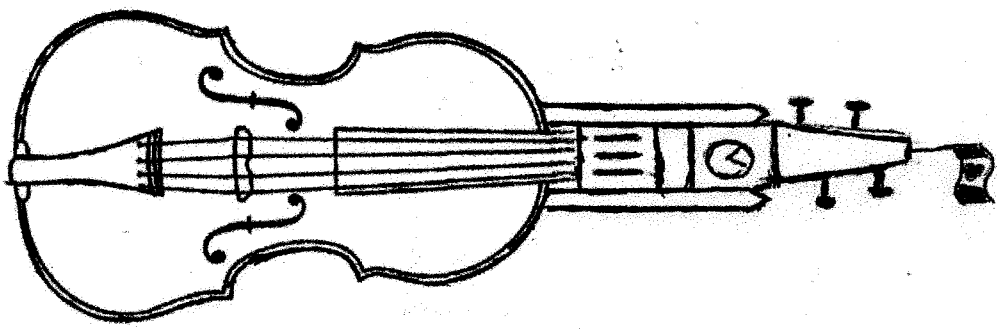
We couldn't do it without you!
